

2018 Official Rules & Information

San Pedro Art Association Student Art Competition And Exhibition

This San Pedro Art Association (SPAA) art event is for all Elementary, Middle and High School students Harbor wide. Student 2-D works that are selected for the exhibit will be shown at Crafted at the Port of Los Angeles from June 3 through September 9, 2016. Crafted is located at 112 E. 22nd St. San Pedro CA 90731.

There will be an opening reception and awards ceremony at Crafted on June 3 from 2 to 5 pm. Refreshments will be served. More information about this event will be sent out later.

Judging will be done by a panel of art professionals. Submitted artwork may be of any appropriate subject matter (at the discretion of the judges).

Art mediums accepted will be: charcoal, pastel (chalk or oil) all drawing materials, all painting materials, photography (darkroom or digital). All "loose" materials (chalk, pastels) must be sprayed with proper fixative. Art should be done on paper, canvas, canvas board, poster board or other surfaces appropriate for the medium. The acceptable standardized sizes for all works (unmatted and unframed) are:

Drawings up to 11" X 15"
Photography - 8" X 10" or 11" X 14"
Canvas board or canvas - up to 16" X 20"

Awards:

Four cash prizes will be awarded at each level (elementary, middle and high school).

1 st Prize:	\$100
2 nd Prize:	\$ 75
3 rd Prize:	\$ 50
Honorable Mention:	\$ 25

In addition, a People's Choice award of \$100 will be awarded to a student who has not won a cash prize. The People's Choice will be determined by a vote of the attendees at the June 3rd reception at Crafted.

All students whose work is accepted into the competition will receive art supplies, a ribbon and a Student Membership in SPAA.

Reproduction:

- Artwork may be reproduced and used to promote SPAA and/or the exhibit at Crafted and for distribution to news organizations and publications.
- Art will be reproduced and made for sale at Crafted and on line to help raise funds for future Student Art Competitions.

Rules:

1. Eligibility: Participants must be between the ages of 4 and 18 (TK -Grade 12) and be schooled in a harbor area (San Pedro, Wilmington, Harbor City, Harbor Gateway South, Harbor Gateway North, Gardena, East Torrance, East Lomita, East Rancho Palos Verdes and South Carson).
2. All students must submit completed and signed release forms. Students 18 years of age may sign their own forms.. No personal information provided on the form will be distributed to outside parties.
3. **The following forms must be filled out in their entirety and turned in with the artwork:**

1) 2018 Official Entry Form/Art Submission

2) The Entry Label

Please affix both forms to the backside of the art.

Incomplete or illegible forms information will disqualify the student's entry.

- 4 Deadline for submission to a school is April 26 Work will be picked up at the school main office on April 27^h. Artwork also may be brought to the SPAA space at Crafted at the Port of Los Angeles from 11:00am and 6:00pm on any Friday, Saturday or Sunday until April 28^h. Crafted is located at 112 E. 22nd St. San Pedro CA 90731.
5. Accepted artwork will be returned to the school of origin in the fall of 2018 or can be picked up at Crafted following the completion of the exhibit on or after September 9th.
